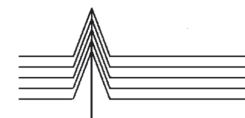

SCOTT MCKEE assumed the full-time position of Managing Director of the American Band College and the Organizing Director of the Western International Band Clinic in August of 2002. He is also the Associate Editor of Bandworld Magazine (online). Scott is a native of Southern Oregon where he attended Ashland High School and played on the first AHS football team to win the state championship in 1989.

He received his bachelors degree from Southern Oregon University and his Master's Degree from the American Band College. He taught seven years in the public schools of Oregon (Scappoose and Springfield), where the concert bands were selected for the state band championships every year they competed.

Scott is the Organizing Director of Western International Band Clinic. In addition to WIBC logistics, he is also the Managing Director of the American Band College and on the WIBC Board of Directors (WIBC, Inc.). He is the founder and director of the Willamette Valley Honor Band, now in its fourth year. Scott is also the co-founder of an international honor band exchange program (Australia, Brazil and USA) called the Pacific Honours Ensemble Program. Since 2002, he has guest conducted/adjudicated bands throughout the United States, parts of Europe and Australia. He is an elected Associate Member of the prestigious American Bandmasters Association.

Scott, his wife, Stacy Swartout-McKee (choir director at Springfield H.S.), and their five children; Dennis, Tanner, Kelsie, Kamryn and Payton, live in the Willamette Valley area.

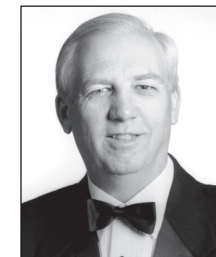
The Willamette Valley Honor Band and W.I.B.C, Inc.
